The cost will be **\$100.00 per gender for High School**, (more below). **\$100.00 per gender for Middle School. \$15 per individual if you have less than a full team.**
Medals will be awarded to the top individuals from each class (1,2,3,4,5) in the varsity races.
No team awards will be presented. JV Races and MS races will be awarded medals as well.

There will be t-shirts for sale.

Course: Course is grass with several cart path crossings. Course is mostly flat and course maps will be made available closer to race day. The course will be open from 6:30 am until race time.

Directions: Enter the course at the main entrance of the Roy Blunt YMCA.

From South - Take North Hwy 13 to Main Bolivar Exit. Exit on Hwy 32 heading East (right turn). The YMCA will be on your right. Just after Meeks.

From North - Take South Hwy 13 to Main Bolivar Exit. Exit on Hwy 32 heading East (left turn). The YMCA will be on your right. Just after Meeks.

Entering Bolivar on Hwy 32 from the East - Follow HWY 32 West all the way through town square. The YMCA is roughly a half mile from the square on your left. Just after the Municipal Golf Course and the Library. Do not enter the Golf Course main entrance. The meet is in the back of the course and YMCA.

Chips: A \$25.00 per chip fee will be issued to schools for any damaged and/or missing chips. We will have individuals collecting your chips at the end of the meet located at the Packet Pick-Up area; however, it is still your responsibility to check and double check your chips before returning them. **Chips must be returned in the packets given, rubber banded and in numeric order.** These individuals will check these in while you wait. Entry Fee: \$100.00 per team. Men and Women count as separate High School teams. Cost includes Varsity and JV as one team. Middle School is separate. \$100 per gender for middle school. \$15.00 per individual. **Make Checks payable to Bolivar Schools.**

Pick-up: Packets may be picked up after 6:30 am near the start line at the White tent.

Facilities: There are no locker rooms located at the course, but portable restrooms will be available.

Bus Parking: As you enter the venue, we will be parking buses / vans at the very back, west side. This will actually be pretty close to the racing and team camps.

Parking: Parking lots at the YMCA will be closed by school Security Officers

Greens/Tees: Please be respectful of the golf course and keep athletes and spectators off all greens and tee boxes.

Awards: Awards will be given to the top 15 individuals of each division: Varsity, JV and MS races. Varsity races are broken down by classification.

MEET SAFETY GUIDELINES

1. We will follow all MSHSAA guidelines for the meet. Athletes must be masked at all times outside of warming up or racing.
2. Teams will be expected to follow MSHSAA guidelines and take athletes' temperatures before loading buses for the trip.
3. We are asking for no fans to attend this first competition. There are a few large invitationals this weekend and they are asking the same of their teams.
4. There will be an athletic trainer at the meet and hopefully EMS like last year.
5. Team camps must be separated with as much distance as can be reasonable. We have plenty of space so this should not be a problem.
6. No awards assembly. Packets of medals can be picked up at main tent at the end of racing.
7. Starting line warm up area. Runners will be asked not to stand in boxes until the 5 min gun fires. We ask that runners do their warm-ups out in the starting area and prepare for their races. If a team has a huddle before the races, please distance from other groups. At the 5 min gun athletes make their way back to starting boxes and be masked up for race instructions. Athletes will be asked to remove masks and the gun will fire as soon as instructions are complete.
8. Finish area. Athletes will be asked to progress through the finish area and head to team camps or back out onto course to cheer on their teams. Athletes and coaches will be asked not to congregate at the finish area. Coaches if an athlete is having a problem of any kind, we understand you will need to be there to aid them. Outside of that please try to keep finish area traffic to a minimum.
9. Water and Ice will be provided at the finish area for emergency purposes only. TEAMS are asked to provide their own water.
10. We are planning on having photographers at the meet to take pictures hopefully of all athletes. The intent is to have these posted in a digital format for parents to have copies of. Not sure on specifics here yet.
11. Only busses will be allowed into the meet arena. School security staff will be present at all entrances to the meet site.
