IF your team overlaps the purple/gold division requirements from one year to the next, you may choose which division to enter. Divisions will race together. Awarded separately.

Course: We take pride in our course – it is mowed pasture with 17 years of previous XC use. In 2021, we’ve widened the course. You’ll notice the new widened edges are not quite as nice as the path that’s existed for 17 years, but it adds a little extra wiggle room for those congested spots. Missouri soil = rocks. We’ve done our best to remove them all, but any rocks/tree roots will be painted and noticeable. Course maps are attached at the end of this document. Spectator Friendly! Keep in mind, however, that it is one way in, one way out and our course crosses the driving path. This obviously can create congestion during a race. Please encourage buses to stay parked, and encourage parents/spectators to arrive early.

Tent City: Set up camp in the area to the right of the starting apron.

Timing/Chips: TRXC will be timing our meet. A \$25.00 per chip fee will be issued to schools for any damaged and/or missing chips. Chips must be returned in the packets given, **rubber banded and in numeric order**. There will be a chip packet drop off located in the red barn where you can pick up your awards.

Entry Fee: \$75 per gender or \$150 per school. OR \$15 per individual per gender for 4 or less.

Packet Pickup: Packets may be picked up after 7:00am at the big red barn.

Facilities: There will be portable restrooms available.

Bus Parking: Busses will be directed to parking locations once they enter the course. IF a bus driver does not plan on parking & staying for the duration of the meet, we recommend they drop the team off at the entrance to the course on Dry Hollow Road as to not congest the one-way in/out driveway during peak drop times. There is additional parking in Ha Ha Tonka State Park at the Visitor’s Center or the Lower Castle parking lots for bus drivers to park & wait if they choose to drop off.

Parking: Spectator parking will be inside the venue. Cars will be directed to a parking location in a grassy field.

State Park: We are so lucky to host our meet at Ha Ha Tonka State Park – which has been named ‘4th best state park in America’, and ‘Most Beautiful Place in Missouri’. We encourage you to come back sometime and check out the beautiful views, historical ruins, and awesome trails. We also want to remind you that our course exists on protected state park property. Please be respectful and pick up trash, don’t venture beyond the outside bounds of the course, keep dogs on leash, and only park in designated locations.
