Events: <u>All events will be run as finals.</u> Each event will have only one heat with the exception of the hurdle relays. The long jump and triple jump areas will be open for one hour. Jumps will be cafeteria style; the best jumps from all three competitors will be added together to determine team place. No tape is allowed on jumping surfaces. Shot and discus will be put into flights (2 teams at a time throwing). Each thrower will be allowed 4 throws; the best throws from all three competitors will be added together to determine team place. High Jump and Pole Vault will be run as a regular meet as far as Heights.

Admission: Rules:	for all non-participants: \$5.00 Adults, \$2.00 Students. We will follow the MSHSAA and National Federation Handbook Rules.
Shoes and Spikes:	Flat shoes in the shot and discus areas. All track events $\frac{1}{4}$ " spikes or smaller are allowed on the track at Howell Central. 1/8" spikes or less on the Javelin runway.
Restrooms:	They are available at the end of the concession stand/entrance to the track.
Hospitality Room:	Will be provided for coaches and event workers.
Concessions:	Will be available.
T-shirts	Will be sold at the meet for \$20. All proceeds from t-shirt sales will be donated to St. Jude Children's Hospital in Coach Bizzell's memory.

The opening height for the **girls' high jump will be 1.32m** with the bar raising .05m after each clearing height.

The opening height for the **boys' high jump will be 1.52** with the bar raising .05m after each clearing height.

The opening height for the **girls' pole vault will be 2.13m** with the bar raising .15m after each clearing height.

The opening height for the **boys' pole vault will be 2.74m** with the bar being raised .15m after each clearing height.

The last clearing height of each 3 jumpers will be added together to determine team place.

We will not be discussing opening heights at the coaches meeting. These will be the opening heights. Please keep this in mind when you enter your athletes for these events

Jump pits will be open for one hour. Jumps will be cafeteria style, the best jumps from all 3 competitors will be added together for team place. NO FINALS.
