- We will follow the MSHSAA and NFHS rules.
- Starting heights will be determined at the coaches meeting.
- Medals Top 3 places -- Plaque for team champion.
- Teams are responsible for their valuables. No dressing facilities will be available.
- Rest rooms are located at the track.
- 1/4" or less spikes are allowed on the track and runway surfaces.
- Flats or 1/8" spikes will be allowed on the javelin runway. This will be checked and enforced.
- No tape, tacks, pins, or medal devices that puncture the surface of the track or runways. Chalk is OK.
- Stay off the football field. Coaches, please help us enforce this.
- Buses will pull into the Spartan Drive entrance (not the main entrance) to drop off athletes at the track.
 We will then need the buses to leave campus the same way they entered and they may return after
 3:00pm. This is when our student parking lot empties. (We will have signage available to direct traffic).
- Tents can be setup between the Visitors Bleachers and the Storage Shed on the North side of the track.
- Admission: \$5 for adults, \$2 for Students, No passes or senior citizen's discount.
