#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. A girl may be entered in four (4) events. Each school may enter one team in each relay and two girls in individual events.
- 2. High jump warm-up at 4'4" and start at 4'6".
- Field events will be open order, cafeteria style (one and one half hour time limit, 75 minutes).
   Four jumps and Four throws in the shot put and discus. Shot put will go first and Discus will follow up.
   Triple Jump will follow Long Jump
- 4. On the track 1/4" pyramid spikes may be worn. On runways 1/4" pyramid spikes or less may be worn.
- 5. Please bring your own starting blocks.
- 6. Teams should set up their team camps on the west side of the track or on the grass at the west side of the track. Please do not use bleachers since this is for fans.
- 7. Track events take precedent over field events. A track event will not be held up because an athlete is competing in a field event. Athletes will have 15 minutes to report back to field events after a race or other competition.
- 8. Teams should come dressed to compete.
- Shot put and discus throwers will be working off concrete and should wear rubber soled shoes.
- 10. Coaches should make scratches or substitutions upon arrival in the press box until 3:30 p.m. A meeting of coaches & a team captain will start at 3:15 p.m. in the bull pen area located near the high jump pit.
- 11. Alton High School assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen property.
- 12. <u>All people</u> not serving as officials or contestants in events being run, <u>must stay in</u> the stadium seats. Each team will be required to work in an area.
- 13. Restrooms and a <u>concession</u> stand will be available on the west side of the stadium..
- 14. NO ATHLETES are allowed on the Soccer field during competition. COACHES we need your assistance on your athletes following this rule.
