- Registration will open Monday April 8<sup>th</sup> @ Midnight and close Wednesday April 17<sup>th</sup> @ 9AM
- Each school will need to provide one adult to assist with officiating. A work assignment will be sent to you prior to the meet entry deadline.
- All-weather track and runway surfaces. Kirkwood is proud to have two separate runways. One for TJ and one for LJ Spikes. Nothing longer than ¼ inch spikes are allowed on the track and anyone found wearing longer spikes will be disqualified.
- Shot and Discus and Javelin competition areas are behind the natatorium, which is behind the gymnasium at the corner of Chopin and Dougherty Ferry Drive..
- Javelin We are pleased to announce we have a brand new 120 feet all-weather synthetic track surface runway. There is a grass area near the new javelin runway where warm ups will take place. Spikes are welcome.
- Pool Information for the SHOT–PUT and DISCUS competition. Each school may use their own throwing implement during warm-up, however, during competition a new pool will be established for each flight in the shot. Athletes are allowed to use their own discus for competition. Athletes are responsible for their implements. Please be sure your implements are marked prior to competition.
- Concessions will be available for the athletes and spectators.
- Trophies will be awarded to the first and second place teams overall. The top six athletes in each event will be awarded medals.
- There will be a \$5.00 entry fee. All athletes and coaches will not be charged. We will need a pass list for your coaches.

- TENT CITY-SPACE will not be provided OUTSIDE the stadium. If you do bring a tent, you are more than welcome to utilize the green space on the north end of the stadium or in the visiting bleachers-PLEASE do not set up tents on the grandstand side.
- Bus Drop Off: Please stop at the top of the hill on Chopin Drive(DO NOT PULL INTO THE SMALL PARKING LOT)-you can drop off of your athletes and they will enter the stadium at the top of the stairs-once athletes are dropped off-please continue NORTH-take a right on Dougherty Ferry Rd. and park in the large parking lot located off of Dougherty Ferry Rd.
