# CUNNINGHAM INVITATIONAL GENERAL INFORMATION SHEET

- 1. The Cunningham Invitational will be held on Thursday, April 18, 2024. There will be a coaches meeting at 3:15pm in the high school commons. Javelin will begin at 3:30 pm with other field events will begin at 4:00pm. Running events will begin at 4:30pm.
- 2. Entry forms will be done online at MOMileSplit. Live Results on TRXC Timing

- 4. Entries are due by Thursday April 18<sup>th</sup> at 9AM NO SUBSTITUTIONS WILL BE ALLOWED THE DAY OF THE MEET, ONLY SCRATCHES.
- 5. Athletes and coaches are being asked to stay away from the finish line area. Athletes are asked to walk through the admission gate when coming back from the shot/discus area. All times will be fully automatic timed and as a result, all events will be run as finals.
- 6. An athlete is limited to four events. All running events, all field events, or any combination.
- 7. A school is limited to two competitors per event, and one team per relay.
- 8. The first six places in each event will be scored 10-8-6-4-2-1. In case of a tie, the point will be divided and the contestants who tie shall flip a coin for the medals.
- 9. Plaques will be awarded to the first place teams. Medals will be awarded to the first six finishers in each individual and relay event.
- 10. If an athlete is competing in a running event and a field event at the same scheduled time, the running event shall receive precedence. The competitor must inform the field judge of the conflict so proper arrangements can be made.
- 11. All personnel, other than officials or contestants must stay off of the track and the infield. This includes coaches. Sections in the stands will be available for coaches and team members not participating in an event in progress.
- 12. Everyone is asked to please stay off of the football field. Walk around the outside of the field.

- 13. Everyone is expected to behave respectfully toward players, coaches and officials, and may be scratched from an event for failure to do so. Profanity will result in meet disqualification
- 14. Pole vaulter's body weight must not exceed the manufacturer's weight on the pole. The coach must initial the event card prior to the meet.
- 15. Coaches and administrators are responsible for supervision. Please have your athlete's pick-up your team camp.
- 16. All contestants must wear official school uniform in accordance with the National Federation Track Rules.
- 17. Spikes in track shoes may be no longer than 3/16" and must be of the PYRAMID shape. NO NEEDLE NOSED SPIKES WILL BE ALLOWED. Athletes will not be allowed to wear shoes that do not follow this guideline.
- 18. Dressing facilities WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE. Please have your athletes dressed and ready to participate.
- 19. DO NOT BRING STARTING BLOCKS, they will be provided.
- 20. The waterfall starting method will be used for the following: 800M run, 1600M run, 3200M run, 4x800M relay.
- 21. Shot, discus, long jump, triple jump and javelin shall have **four trials**, no finals. Long jump and triple jump shall be run cafeteria style, with a one-hour time limit. Shot and discus shall be run three alive. A contestant may take two throws in a row. All shot and discus implements will be pooled. An athlete must pool their implements at the beginning of the event, and cannot take the implements until the event is completed.
- 22. The meet management has tried to free the coaches from duties during the meet, but in emergency coaches may be asked to help run a field event.
- 23. Entry fees will be \$100.00 per team entered; \$200.00 for both boys and girls teams.
- 24. Relay athletes and alternate rules will be in effect as per the National Federation Rule Book.
- 25. Buses park in the main high school parking lot.
- 26. All medals will be placed in a packet for coaches to pick-up after the meet. Please stay out of the press box.
