# Meet Information – Willmore Park – 7200 Hampton Avenue or Francis Park – 6300 Eichelberger Street

Metro Academic and Classical High School and STEAM Academy at McCluer South-Berkeley invite you to a boys and girls cross country meet to be held at Willmore Park in Saint Louis on Thursday, March 18, 2021. Due to field conditions, meet may move to Francis Park, Willmore Park is currently very wet. We will make the determination on Monday.

Event Schedule: 3:30 – Coaches Meeting

4:00 – Girls 4:45 – Boys

Race Information: We will have two races, girls first and boys second. We are running for pride, no awards will be handed out at this meet.

Entries: Entry deadline will be done on Tuesday, March 16<sup>th</sup> at 5pm. MoMileSplit

Scratches/Changes: Coaches can manage their entries until Wednesday, March 17<sup>th</sup> BY NO LATER THAN 9AM.

#### Chip Collection:

- Coaches will return all chips to the finish line after the conclusion of all races in the envelope provided in your packet.
- Chips should be strung in numeric order.
- No chips will be collected in the finish chute.
- A \$20.00 fee will be assessed for missing or damaged timing chips.

## Rules/Expectations:

- All teams are expected to complete health screening of all their participants, coaches, etc. prior to attending and to turn in the attached form
- Spectators are allowed along the race course but must maintain social distancing and to be wearing masks
- Remind all athletes of the uniform and jewelry rule.
- Participants Mask on: talking, sitting, stretching, after race
- Participants Mask off: warm up, race
- Everyone else should be masked at all times
- Bring own water
- No congregating, especially with other teams
- Coaches should have someone assigned to pick up dropped runners
- Trainer will focus only on critical needs

Starting Line: In an effort to keep runners socially distanced at the starting line, there will be the starting line, 3M step line and an additional line 6 feet back. Runners will stay in this line up for instructions, etc. Once race is set to be they will all step up to start line (only be next to someone a few seconds) before they are off.

Marshals: Each of the participating schools is asked to have 1 coach to serve as a marshal. He/she will be throughout the course. They are there to give direction to runners and note any infractions. Additional provided by the PHL and Metro.



Course Information: I have enclosed a map of the course, there may be a slight adjustment. Feel free to tour th at any time prior to the meet.

Restrooms: Park Restrooms are not currently available, 2 Portable Toilets will be made available.

Expenses: Will be divided evenly based on total number of runners


