<u>Dressing Area</u>: All athletes should come prepared to run as there are no dressing rooms; we are not responsible for lost articles.

<u>High Jump & Pole vault</u> Starting heights will be determined at the coach's meeting. The bar will be successively elevated 5cm at a time for high jump 15cm for pole vault.

(All warm-ups need to be taken prior to start of event.)

Shot, discus, LJ and TJ: Will have 4 trials and no finals; time limit of an hour and 15 minutes in the long and triple jump We will make every attempt to allow only active participants into the track area. Please help us to police the meet, especially in the high jump/pole vault area and the walkway by the long and triple jump pits as these tend to get crowded with people.

Track Surface: The facility is an 8-lane, all-weather track. Spikes up to 3/16" will be allowed.

<u>Medals</u>: We will medal 1st-5th in each event, with 6-8thplace receiving points only. The meet will consist of one division for both boys and girls. (No Grade Level Divisions) There will be team scoring and a plaque will be awarded to the top two team places in both the boys and girls divisions.
