Track Info: 8 Lane all-weather track. You may only use 1/4" spikes or smaller. Spectators must stay in the stadium as they will not be allowed on the infield.

Scoring: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1

Entries: Each school is allowed **2** entries per open event and 1 relay team per event for **VARSITY** and **4** entries per open event with only the top 2 scoring and 1 relay team per for **JUNIOR VARSITY**. **Entries are due Thursday, May 5th, by 9:00 am registered on [MoMilesplit](#).**

Horizontal jumps and throws will have 4 attempts for Varsity and 3 attempts for Junior Varsity with no finals for either division. Seniors may compete at the Junior Varsity division if their performance is as such. **There will be no crossover divisions!**

Extra Events:

Buffalo Relay for athletes that participate in a throwing event

Entry Fee:

This fee will be divided equally among the schools.

Details:

Each team is to assist with officiating.

All-weather track and runway surfaces. Two separate runways one for TJ and one for LJ. Spikes *no longer than 1/4 inch* are allowed on the track. Anyone found wearing long spikes will be disqualified.

Shot and Discus locations are located on the upper softball field located near Dougherty Ferry. The javelin will be contested on the Baseball field.

RESTROOMS: Restrooms are located at the North end of the Stadium on each side of the concessions stand as well as on the grandstand side of the stadium.

FIRST AID: A certified trainer will be available on site

Coaches meeting: 3:45 IN THE BULLPEN

ASSIGNMENTS: Each team will be assigned to run off at least one field event /relay or hurdle engineer. If you have a preference, please email me.

Admission: Please inform your parents that there will be a \$5.00 admission fee charged at the gate.

Concessions: will be available for the athletes and spectators.

AWARDS: Medals for the 3 places in the varsity and junior varsity divisions & Team Trophy will be awarded medals.

TENTS: Tent space will be in the upper field or inside the stadium (TBD)
